
In this lesson, you will learn how to form 2 to 4letter words in Yoruba

Learning Tip



When a **consonant letter** starts a word, and is immediately **followed by a vowel letter**, both letters are **pronounced as a syllable.**



When a **vowel letter** starts a word, we **pronounce the vowel first as a separate syllable** before pronouncing the consonant and immediate vowel together as another another syllable.




